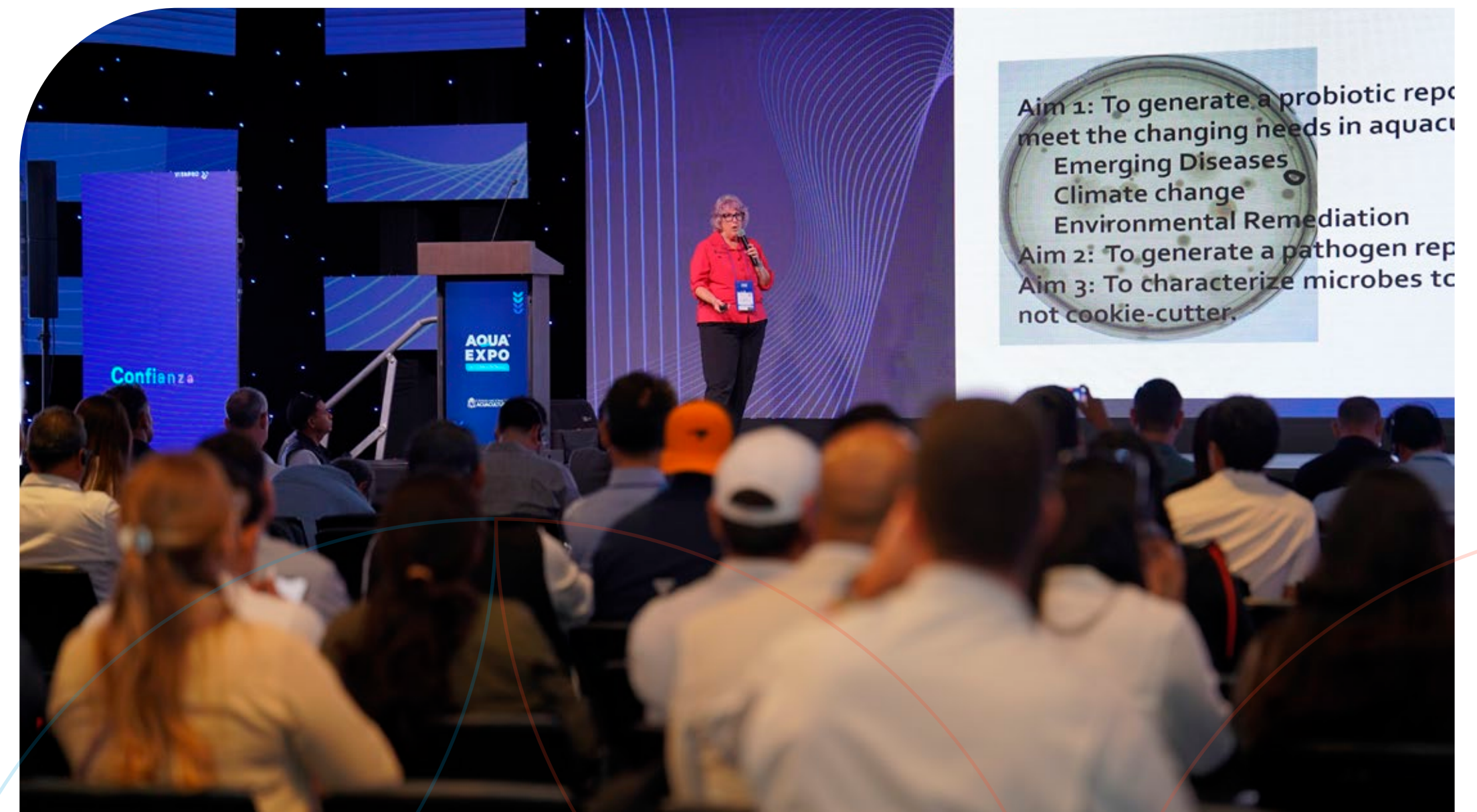

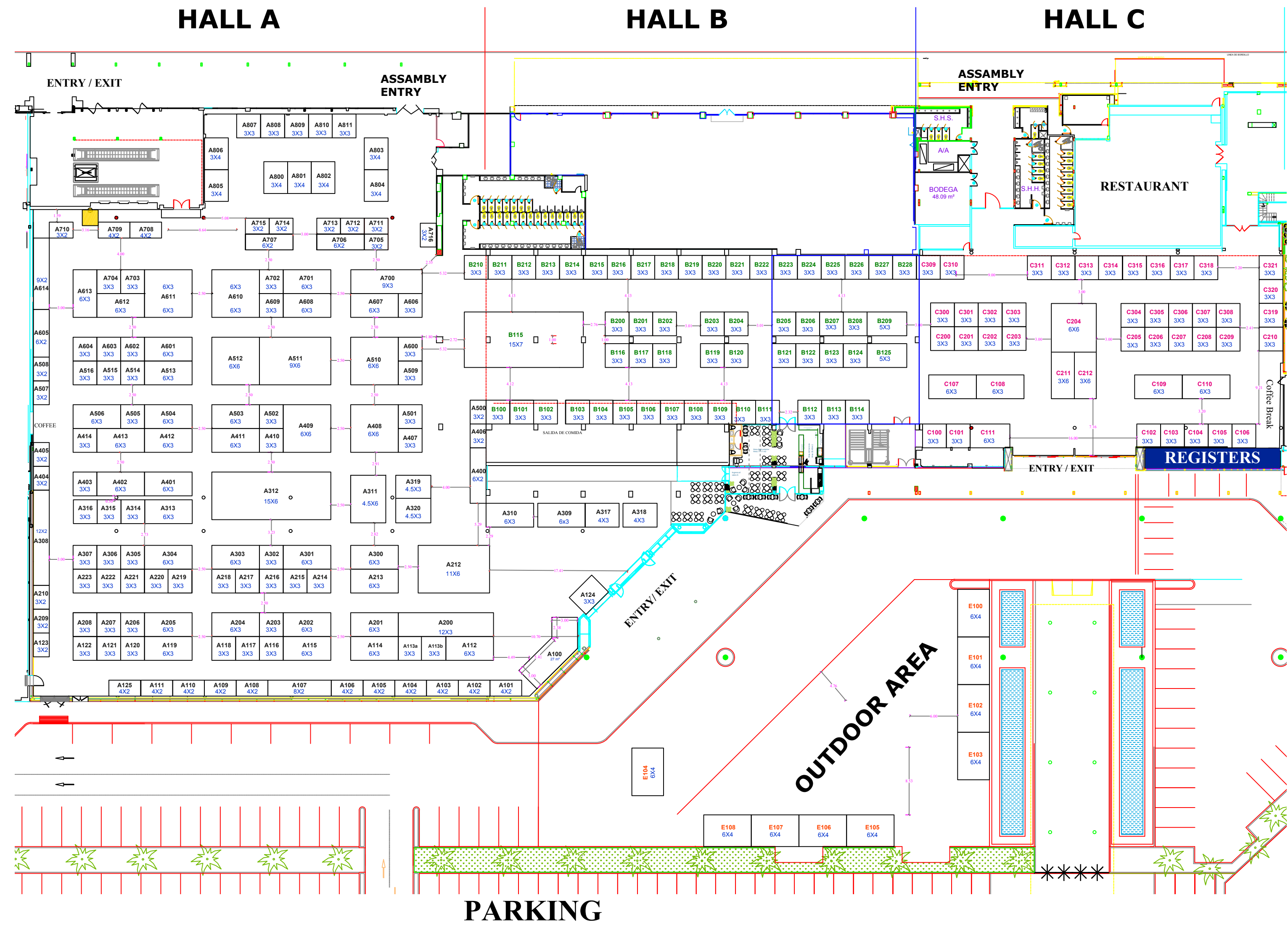
With a space of 7,000 m², the trade show will host hundreds of booths where executives and technicians from participating companies will present the highlights of their product portfolio to attendees.



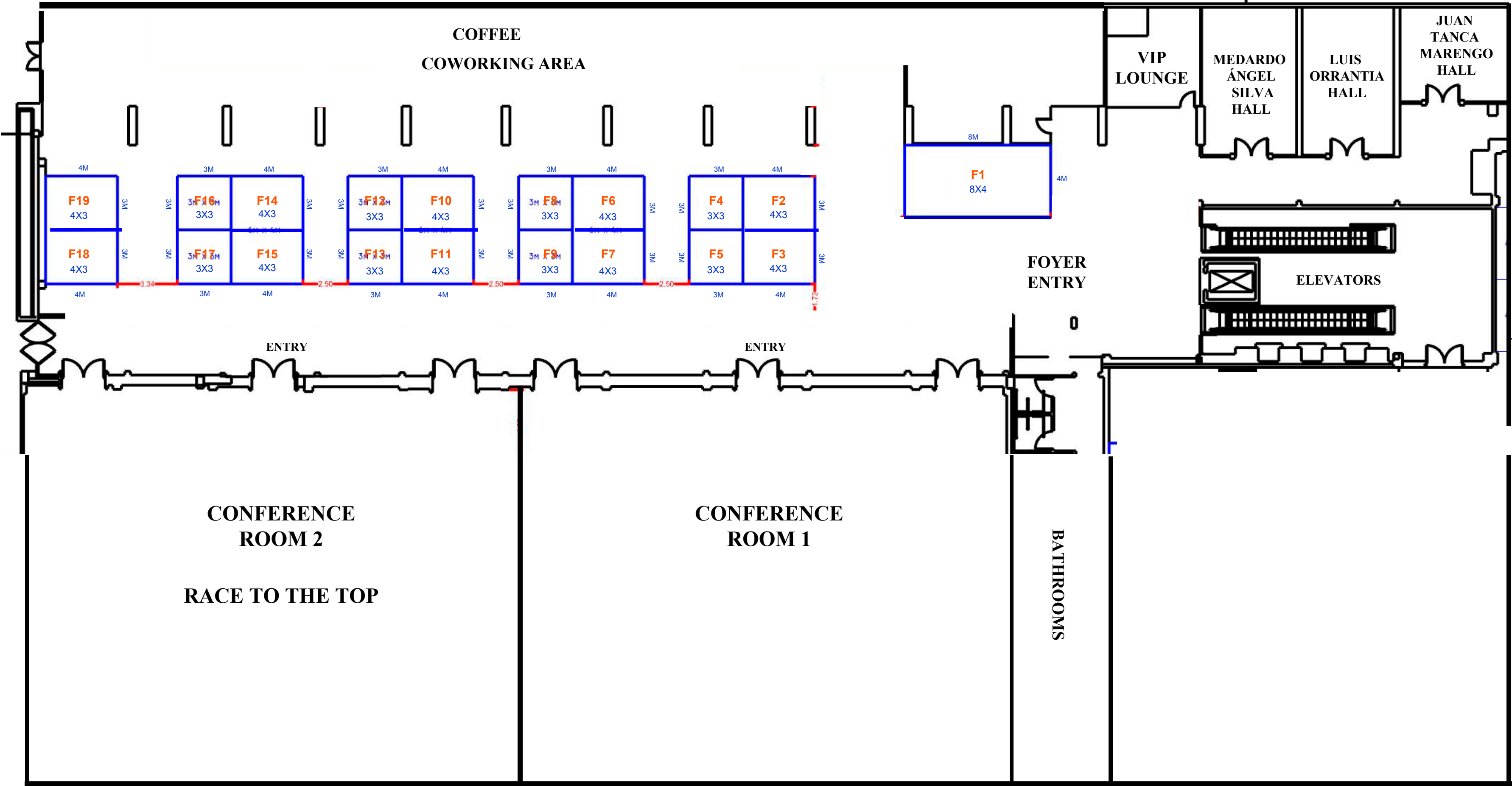


TRADE SHOW FLOOR PLAN

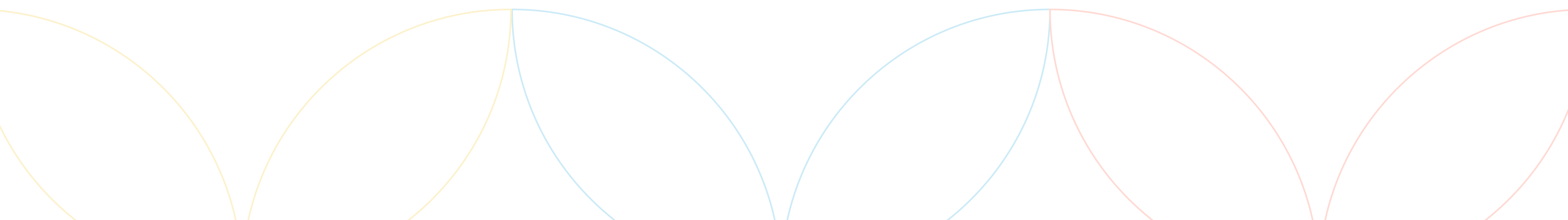

APPLICATION PROCESS FOR TECHNICAL PRESENTATIONS

Those interested in submitting technical presentations must complete the submission process, which includes sending a detailed summary of their proposal and an updated résumé. This information is essential to evaluate the relevance and profile of the presentation within the selected topics for AQUAEXPO.

Instructions for abstract preparation:

- Abstracts should be sent for evaluation to the AQUAEXPO Technical Committee in a Word document, written in Spanish or English, with a length of 500 to 1200 words, excluding the title and keywords.
- The abstract must include the following information, where applicable:
 - Complete information about the authors (underline the name of the speaker)
 - Institution and location where the research was conducted
 - Objectives
 - Methodology used
 - Observations
 - Results (tables and/or images may be included in the presentation)
 - Conclusions

AQUAEXPO does not promote brands or specific commercial

products, but rather highlights the benefits of the active principle, instrument, machinery, software, or service in a generic way. Therefore, the inclusion of trademarks of the products used in the tests is not accepted, only the generic names or active principles of the product, or the type of service that is to be shown.

- The congress is parallel, but independent of the trade show. Hiring a booth is neither a requirement nor a guarantee that the participating company will have space for a technical conference.
- It is recommended that submissions not be identical to those previously presented at similar events, either nationally or internationally. If presenting a previously discussed topic, it is suggested to include updated data and tailor the presentation to align with the audience's interests.

The deadline for abstract submission is JULY 27, 2026.

GUAYAQUIL

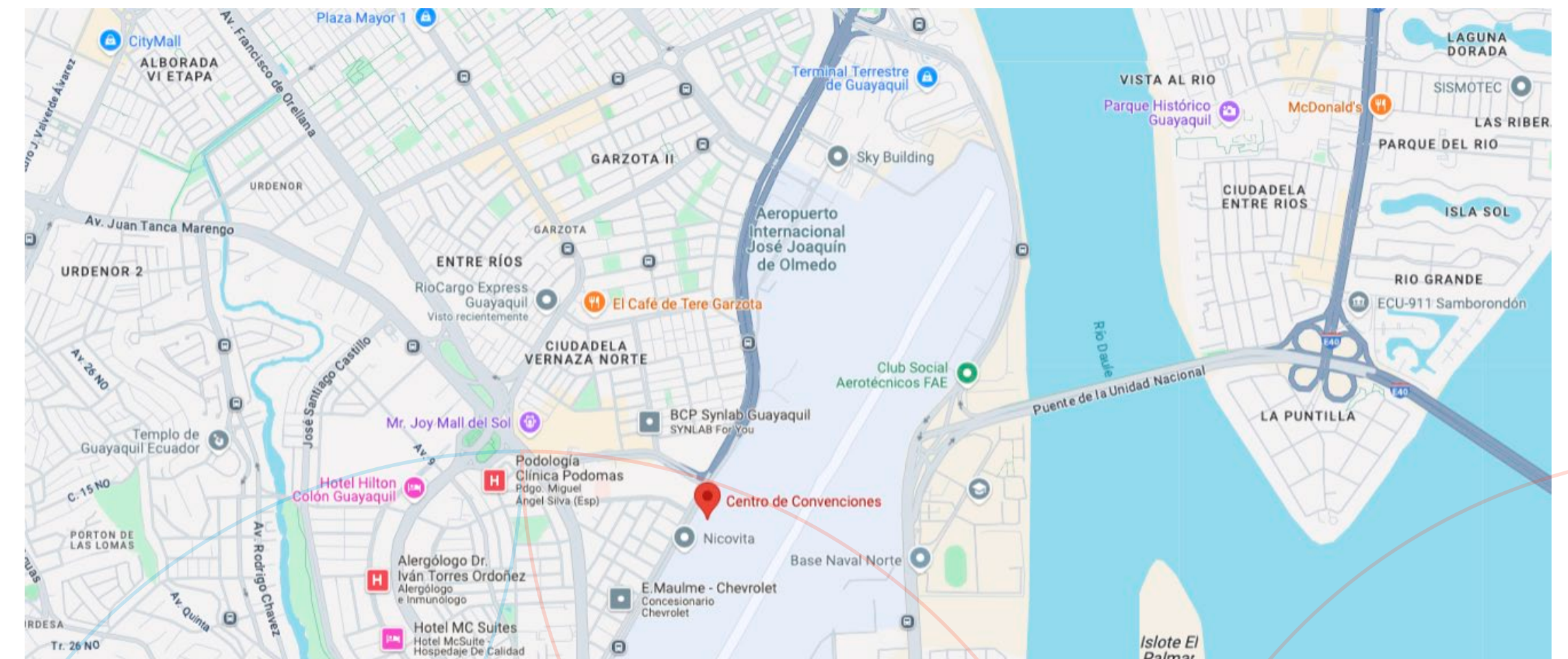
Ecuador's largest city, offers a wide range of tourist attractions ranging from its rich history to its vibrant night life and beautiful natural areas.

VISA APPLICATION

1. Register with a personal e-mail address.
2. Complete the form with the required information.
3. Upload the requested documents (valid passport, photograph, etc.).
4. Make the corresponding payment.

For some countries, a key requirement for the visa application is the Police Clearance Certificate (PCC), which must be apostilled and translated into Spanish. While waiting for the PCC, the visa application process with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs can be initiated in parallel to save time and ensure that all documents are ready once the PCC is completed.

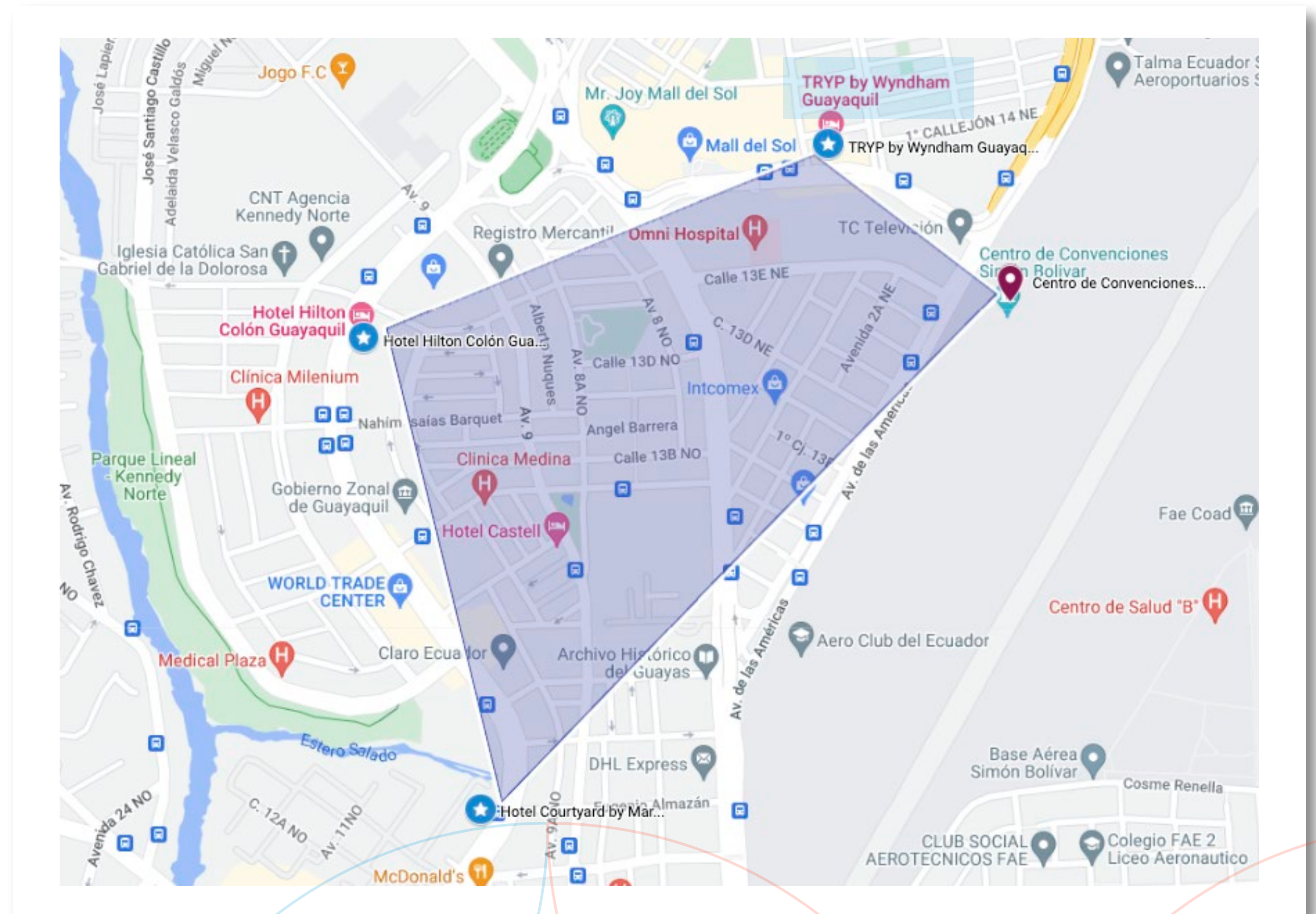


RECOMMENDATIONS

- Start the process early enough to avoid setbacks and ensure your participation in the event.
- Verify that your passport is valid for at least 6 months after the date of your intended stay in Ecuador.
- Check with your local Ecuadorian embassy or consulate for the most up-to-date visa requirements, as they may vary from country to country.
- Be prepared to submit additional documentation if requested by Ecuadorian authorities.

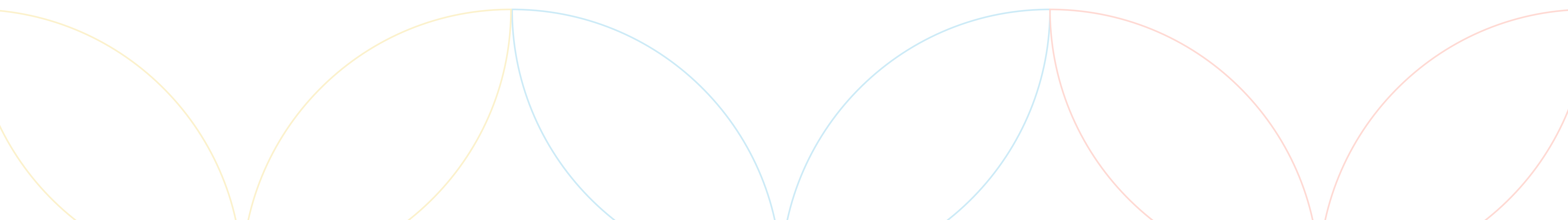

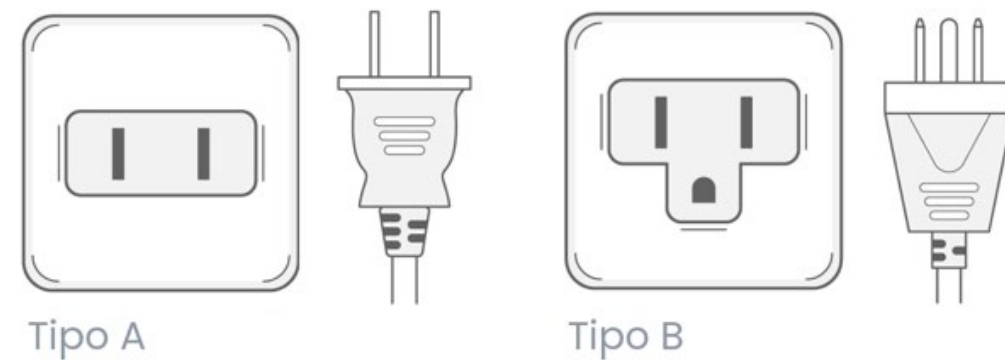

✓ GENERAL TRAVEL AND CULTURAL INFORMATION

- **Currency type:** U.S. dollar - USD.
- **Electric current:** In Ecuador the common voltage is 120 V and the frequency is 60 Hz. The plugs and sockets are type A/B. In the following images you can see the types of plugs and sockets.



- **Weather:** The weather in Guayaquil during the month of October is somewhat hot.
- Daily maximum temperatures hover around 29 °C/84.2 °F and rarely fall below 27 °C/80.6 °F or exceed 31 °C/87.8 °F.
- Daily minimum temperatures hover around 21 °C/69.8 °F, and rarely fall below 20 °C/68 °F or rise above 23 °C/73.4 °F.
